Why

Summer arts is a time to expand your horizons, to reach within ourselves and to offer what you find to the world around you through song, art, poetry, the spoken word and more. We begin by creating a space, the stage upon which we orchestrate our skills in the creation of a worship experience which we can share with the congregation and with the community.

What



Participants will be supported by professionals including an artist and a minister as they craft their worship and create the items they choose to include with it. They may want to paint or make prints on the enclosure we'll be using, or maybe write a poem for the order of service. They can choose a reading or a song to share, or write and deliver a homily. They may incorporate elements of youth worship, or a dance. There are many choices and lots of help to bring them together into a meaningful whole.

The first three Sundays will be spent getting ready. The first public worship will be after church in the patio on the third Sunday. In the remaining weeks the group will go to a different site every other week. When they don't go, they prepare for the next off-site trip.

When and Where



The dates are July 5th through August 23rd with a follow-up session on August 30th. The hours are 10:00 am to 12:15 pm. All sessions begin at the church in the chapel. Off-site locations will be announced at least one week before the trip.

Who and How



This a multigenerational program. Both adults and children are welcome to attend. Every child under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or have written parental permission to be accompanied by another adult.

You may attend as many sessions as you wish but you will get more from this experience if the sessions you attend are consecutive.
